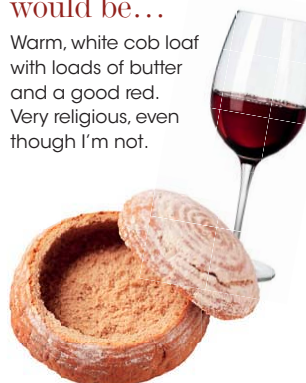
MOST OF MY TIME IS TAKEN UP BY...
